## Prevention against the Virus AH1N1 Cupeyville School Protocol

### To ensure your child's safety and health, the school has taken the following measures:

- ✚ Each classroom will have a hand sanitizer dispenser.
- ✚ Hand sanitizer dispensers have been installed around the school.
- ✚ All school areas have been disinfected with antibacterial detergents and will be disinfected daily.
- ✚ Keyboards, mouse, stairs, banisters, door knobs and bathrooms will be cleaned continuously.
- ✚ Classroom learning areas (blocks, manipulatives, educational materials) will not be used until further notice.
- ✚ Information Center books may not be checked out from the library until further notice.
- ✚ Teachers will ensure that students follow sanitizing measures frequently.

### Each student must bring:

- ✚ Clorox wipes, Lysol wipes or Antibacterial wipes
- ✚ Hand Sanitizer or Alcohol Towelettes
- ✚ Bottled Water
- ✚ Facial tissue paper (Kleenex)
- ✚ 3<sup>RD</sup> – 12<sup>TH</sup> grade students must label all their materials before arriving on Monday, August 10, 2009.
- ✚ Pre-kinder – 2<sup>ND</sup> grade – All materials will be labeled in the classroom. Remember to send the labels with your child.
- ✚ Air conditioners will be operating on high. **All students must wear any jacket until school jackets are sold.**

### STUDENTS WILL NOT BE ALLOWED TO SHARE MATERIALS.

### Parents we need your cooperation and support by:

- ✚ Not sending your child to school if he/she has any cold or flu symptoms such as: Fever, headache, muscle and/or joint ache, cough or sneezing, nasal congestion or cold.
- ✚ Students who present cold or flu symptoms must bring a health certificate from his/her doctor in order to return to school.
- ✚ Please talk to your child about the importance of physical contact.

### STUDENTS SHOULD AVOID:

1. Kissing
2. Hand shaking
3. Hugging
4. Sharing food, drinks and personal belongings
